- Django is very friendly with people, easy to handle and shows signs of being housebroken. We doesn't want to share his kennel with another dog, but may do better with others in a home setting.
- Django is geriatric and has multiple health issues. He will not thrive in the shelter long-term nor is it humane to keep him here in an inherently stressful environment.
- X-rays taken showed: "Bridging discospondylosis L-S junction. Irregular margins femoral heads; subjective decreased acetabular coverage (L>R). L tibial tuberosity irregular slop/margins with subjective increased opacity (soft tissue) joint (stifle). Suspect osteoarthritis, hipo dysplasia IVDD +/- stifle disease. RX Carprofen SID 5 days. VE recheck improvement toe touching L hind with suspect arthritis on NSAID Q5D +/- additional dx/tx +/- clear for general."
- Additionally, the veterinarian noted: "Severe dental disease. Moderate sized gingival mass left lower molar region. cannot rule out oral neoplasia or epulis."
- Information has been previously shared with rescue partners on multiple occasions, no interest received.

He will lunge and bite at another dog if given the opportunity, shows difficulty in breaking focus on another dog. Given the shelter environment requires the housing of hundreds of dogs at any given time, this is not a safe environment to keep Sweet Boy in long-term.

A586032 allowed full handling from 175, but did get a bit pushy for treats (demand barking). 175 practiced appropriate behavior rewards and waited for him to sit politely or not bark before giving him a treat. No issues observed; easily handled, social seeking.

ABC 175 and 180 pulled A592386 for re-assessment. A592386 allowed leashing easily and was very excitable and loose/wiggly. In the yard, A592386 was social seeking and playful, allowing full handling without issue. A592386 would become slightly mouthy but listened to verbal correction and was more-so wanting affection/touch. 180 brought out a spayed female, A592883. At first, A592386 presented with loose body language and disinterest. A592386 then went to the fence, paused, and snapped at A592883. 180 brought A592883 into the yard. A592386 was neutral, but did have a fixated stare. A592386 approached with low tail wag, both dogs sniffed nose-to-nose for one second, and then A592386 lunged forward; did not make contact as 175 pulled him away in time.

Recommendation: Discuss. A592386 has shown severe mental/behavioral decline towards other animals and should not go to a home with other animals.
