All the animals' observations and medical notes have also been included in an attachment for your convenience.

Failure to do so may result in a delay and failure of your message to reach the appropriate individuals at Animal Services.**

[ADOPTER] MENTION CERTAIN INTERESTING BEHAVIOR TO NOTE: DOG WILL NOT GO UP OR DOWN STAIRS- IT TOOK THREE DAYS TO CONVINCED/ GAIN TRUST TO FOLLOW UP AND DOWN. DOG IS VERY MOUTHY DURING PLAY: EXCITED NIPS AND GNAWS AT BARE FEET WITH TEETH. NO BREAKING OF SKIN.

- Dog has ongoing rectal mass that bleeds intermittently. OCAS is unable to fully diagnose and treat the mass in the shelter environment, dog will require further diagnostics and care through another veterinary clinic.

- Dog is unable to share space with other dogs, this behavior has been observed at OCAS and previously at SCAS as well. Recommended to be only dog in her future home.

ABC 175 and 181 pulled A587801 for assessment. A587801 was a bit timid with leashing but allowed it. Once out, A587801 walked nicely. In the yard, A587801 was very food motivated and attentive to handlers. A587801 allowed full handling and leaned into handlers. A587801 then became overstimulated and began clawing and gripping onto 181's arm. 175 pulled her away, but A587801 remained fixated on 181. 175 clipped A587801 to the fence to calm down and she did. When 175 went to interact with her, A587801 clasped onto 175's leg and began humping/mounting 175. 175 was able to push her off without incident. 175 then went and grabbed a senior spayed female. A587801 showed very conflicted body language towards the other dog. A587801 would switch from fixated, hard stare, and stiff body, to fearful and tail tucked. A587801 then became over threshold and began vocalizing and lunging forward. Did not proceed with pairing attempt due to prior hand notes and prior shelters' notes listing her as a single dog only.

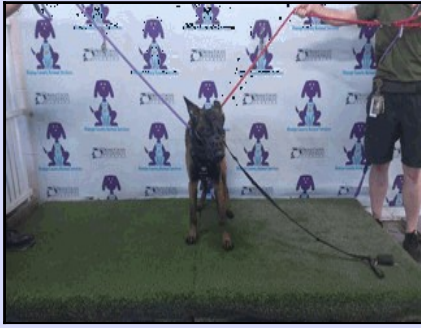

ABC 175 pulled A594976 for further assessment and socialization. A594976 greeted 175 with loose/wiggly body language and allowed leashing easily. Once outside, A594976 became immediately reactive towards the play group that was happening in play yard 8. A594976 charged forward with vocalization and piloerection. 175 verbally corrected and asked A594976 for a sit. A594976 would turn and sit at handler; 175 would give A594976 a treat only when A594976 was non-reactive and attention was on handler or attention was on stimuli with no reaction. In the yard, A594976 jumped on handler for attention and was social seeking and playful, grabbing toys and running around. A594976 was very heightened and reactive to outward stimuli. Any noise, person, or dog on the other side of the fence would cause A594976 to charge, vocalize, and lunge. 175 would verbally correct and divert attention, but A594976 would continue to escalate any time external stimuli appeared. ASO 238 walked by and A594976 charged the fence with vocalization. 238 entered the yard and 175 had leash, waited for A594976 to loosen up, and then allowed A594976 to greet 238. Once A594976 sniffed, A594976 loosened up and allowed handling from 238 as well. Handlers let A594976 run around for a bit, but A594976 continued to show extensive reactivity throughout outing. 175 then placed A594976 back into kennel without incident.

Recommendation: A594976 shows extensive reactivity and outward aggression towards select individuals (potential stranger danger and/or protectiveness of handler), showing a willingness to bite. Rescue Only or No Candidate.

ABC 175 and 181 pulled A594976 for re-assessment. A594976 was fearful in the kennel and retreated to the back, so 175 closed the divider and went to the back-side. 175 opened the kennel run and A594976 gave a low tail wag and greeted 175, allowing leashing. A594976 walked nicely on leash to the yard. In the yard, A594976 immediately sought social with 175 and hopped in handlers' lap for attention. A594976 allowed full handling and was playful/affectionate with handler. 181 sat next to 175 on the bench and handed A594976 treats. A594976 would sit and give paw for treats and did not show any outward reactivity to 181. Any time that a new person walked by the yard, A594976 would show extensive reactivity by rushing the fence with heavy vocalization, piloerection, and snapping. A594976 could be directed away and would listen to command and direct attention to handler. Towards the end of the assessment, 181 stood up and A594976 hard stared and lunged forward at 181. 175 verbally corrected and asked A594976 for a sit. A594976 sat. A594976 became reactive to external stimuli again and lunged at 181 again. Due to A594976 hitting threshold, 175 placed A594976 back into kennel without incident. Recommendation: Continue with Rescue Only designation. A594976 appears to be very protective of handler (whomever is holding the leash) and will need extensive training with an experienced handler.

ABC 175 and 180 went out to play yard 6 where ASO 238 had A594976 out. A594976 was initiating play and was loose/wiggly with 238. When 175 and 180 walked up to the yard, A594976 charged the fence with vocalization, piloerection, growling, and hard stare. 238 picked up the leash and 175 and 180 entered the yard. A594976 calmed down and was able to sniff both 175 and 180 and shake it off. A594976 was more-so attached to one handler (238) but did coexist neutrally with 175 and 180 and allowed petting. A594976 showed extensive insecurity and undersocialization, as A594976 would charge the fence at any new person that walked by. A594976 appears to struggle with 'stranger danger' and does not react appropriately to new people, needing very slow and proper introduction. A594976 would also become overwhelmed and appeared to get sensory overload, as any loud noises would trigger A594976 to become reactive as well. Recommendation: A594976 is young and shows extensive undersocialization, resulting in fear reactivity and poor bite inhibition. Due to this, A594976 will need to go to an experienced handler and will need further training/socialization. Placing as Rescue Only.
